Position Purpose: Under supervision of Building Official performs technical building and fire inspections and plans examining work to enforce compliance with building codes, regulations and ordinances; research new construction materials and methods; reviews plans for compliance with city, state, and federal rules and regulations; and provides information to and works with the public to resolve problems.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND ABILITIES

- Make field inspections of light commercial and residential buildings during various stages of construction and remodeling to assure compliance with applicable codes and regulations of the Town, Maricopa County, State of Arizona and U.S. government agencies.
- Perform complex inspection duties in trade specialties including plumbing, electrical, mechanical and structural.
- Ascertain conformance to building code, fire, mechanical, plumbing and electrical codes, and pertinent provisions of state and county health and environmental ordinances.
- Inspect concrete, masonry, wood framing, light gauge steel framing, drywall, plastering, plumbing, heating and electrical installations, and a large variety of other complex and routine building system elements.
- Check stud, joist, rafter spacing, lateral resistance elements, and other structural member factors.
- Examine grade, quality, and treatment of lumber, concrete, masonry and light gauge steel.

- Make field inspections for the Engineering Department for grading and drainage compliance to approve plans and inspect right-of-way permits for compliance with MAG standards.
- Assure proper and safe installations in routine and complex building systems.
- Confer with architects, contractors, builders, and the general public in the field and office.
- Explain and interpret requirements and restrictions.
- Keep records and prepare reports in a computerized software system.
- Coordinate inspection activities with other Town departments and divisions.
- Make field reviews of plans and specifications.
- Assist in zoning and general land use and code enforcement inspection work as assigned.
- Perform other related work as assigned.
